

# The Perfect Anointing

The word anoint means-to pour. People are anointed to symbolize the introduction of a sacramental or divine influence. Anointing makes a

man useful for God's work and His Kingdom. In fact, there is an anointing for every task in the God's Kingdom, and only those who are anointed for a task can do it best.

Perfect anointing is attained in a state of deep sleep. This kind of anointing is not possible otherwise because men are very restless and do not allow God to work in them. One has to get into the heart of God and His Word. When a man is deeply and perfectly resting in the Lord, He takes out the things that are not required and replaces them with what should be there. This is exactly what God did for Adam. He put him into a state of deep sleep, then took a rib and created Eve from it, closed up the flesh, and then finally presented Eve to Adam.

What's noteworthy is that the Bible does not say anywhere that Adam requested God to find him a suitable helper or a wife. God decided for Himself that Adam was ready and presented Eve to him. He can do the same for you too. But are you ready? Are you listening to what God is trying to tell you? Are you resting in the Lord — perfectly? When you can answer all of these questions with an unequivocal "Yes," God won't lose a minute in giving you what you need.

## The People of the Resurrection

Everything is inside us. However, when we allow the things of this world – lust for money, property, luxuries, wantonness – to take God's place in our life, we inadvertently open the door of our heart and mind to sin. This sin then blots out the light above and within, and keeps us from receiving God's blessings.

Ephesians 2:6 says God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus. We are seated with Christ far above all rule and authority, power and dominion. Yes, we are the people of the Resurrection. When God raised Jesus from the dead, He raised us with Him.



administer it? And who is qualified to do so? Is "reporting" equivalent to "registering a complaint"?

Experience shows very few know how to correct, and even fewer understand the right reasons. A correction is essentially for the benefit of the person receiving it. A father corrects a son so that the latter may become a better person and inculcate good qualities to conduct himself well in private and public. Most importantly, the person correcting must be able to gauge the shortterm and long-term effects beforehand and administer correction accordingly.

As Jonah sat at the east of the city to observe what would happen next, the sun bore down on him. Then, God caused a plant to sprout up and provide him some shade. Jonah was very happy. But next day, God sent a worm to devour the plant. With the sun bearing down on him again with all intensity, Jonah became very angry about not having the plant to shade him anymore. Then the Lord corrected him saying, "You have been concerned about this plant, though you did not tend it or make it grow. It sprang up overnight and died overnight. And should I not have concern for the great city of Nineveh, in which there are more than a hundred and twenty thousand people who cannot tell their right hand from their left—and also many animals?"

#### **Human Correction**

A "correction" done solely for the personal benefit of the corrector is not correction, but rejection. It is tantamount to misuse of power. A good correction, first and foremost, helps the person being corrected to become better.

Jonah finally understood God's point of view.

That's how our God is. And He has a unique way of correcting each one of us.

## God's Way of Correction


God's corrections are scriptural and based at the heart of human salvation. Proverbs 3:12 says: "the LORD disciplines those He loves, as a father the son He delights in". Divine correction always has one sole purpose: to save our soul. Saving a soul and keeping it saved is not a one-time effort. It is an ongoing process. God works in (and for) a person continually. In retrospect, "saving a soul" essentially means making a person fit for heaven.

Correcting people is a very skilful task. Jesus condemned the unproductive and non-fruit bearing fig tree to be trashed to the fire. What He was actually implying is that when a man does not bear fruits of the Holy Spirit - Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Gentleness, Goodness, Self-Control - he faces eternal condemnation. The main aim of correction should be to build character with a view to save the soul.

## Correction by a "Shepherd"

A shepherd may correct someone with the intention of setting him right with God and His Word. This is one of





But if you have, then having experienced these beautiful realities, you follow the Son of God who is your true shepherd. But in your walk, if you have been snared by the lures of the world, or the lusts of the flesh, or the pride of life that clung on to you, do not despair.

If you say to yourself "Oh, I could not give up 'that' for my Lord", learn this: It is not about giving up something for JESUS. Instead, it is about an exchange!

If you really are 'living in the Spirit' as BMM members, then you would have experienced that there are many things that you can do without. As I walk with Jesus, I keep finding that I can live without 'sin', but I cannot live without His 'Peace'. And when I am aware of this truth, I exchange 'sin' for His 'PEACE'!

c. Sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need


- d. Met together in the temple courts
